FUNERAL OF ELIZABETH DURR

DECATUR, Ind., Aug 6 - Funeral services for Elizabeth Durr, aged 83, widow of George Durr, was held Wednesday afternoon at 2 o'clock from the South Salem Methodist church in charge of the Rev. Karl Thompson. Her maiden name was Elizabeth Glosser and she was born in Crawford County, O. She had lived here for more than fifty years. Death occurred at the home of her son, John Durr, in Blue Creek township. She was first married to Charles Myers, now deceased, and a son, Samuel Myers, from this marriage, survives, he residing in Cincinnati, O. Three children from the second marriage survive. They are Henry and John Durr, of Blue Creek, and Annis Ray, of Monroe township. Death resulted following a six years' illness of paralysis.

Karl Thompson officiating.
