## CHARLES W. FEASEL IS TAKEN BY DEATH

Funeral Services Thursday Afternoon

Charles William Feasel, 84, a lifelong resident of Adams county, died at 3:02 o'clock Monday afternoon at his home, 329 Line street, following a year's illness of complications.

He was born in Blue Creek township Jan. 27, 1874, a son of John V. and Rebecca Tyndall-Feasel, and was married to Emma Saum Oct. 28, 1894. Mrs. Feasel preceded her husband in death.
