James Frank Dies Monday Afternoon
Funeral Services Thursday Morning

James Collins Frank, 79, former owner of a grocery store at Glenmore, O., died at 2:55 o'clock Monday afternoon at his home, one and one-fourth miles east of Salem, following an illness of two weeks.

He was born in Adams County, October 27 1870, a son of John and Sarah Chilcote-Frank, and was married to Della Myers March 2, 1898. The family had lived near Salem for the past nine years.

Surviving in addition to his wife are a brother, David Frank of Sturgis, Mi., and a number of nieces and nephews. Two brothers and one sister preceded him in death.

Funeral services will be held at 10 a.m. Thursday at the home and at 10:30 o'clock at the Union U. B. Church, the Rev. L. A. Middaugh and the Rev. J. Angel officiating. The body will be removed from the Zwick Funeral Home to the residence at 7 o'clock this evening.
