DEATH CLAIMS MRS. MANLEY - Mrs. C. O. Manley Dies Thursday Night Of Pneumonia

Mrs. Mae Manley, age 40, wife of C. O. Manley of Blue Creek township and mother of 13 children, died at 10 o'clock Thursday night of pneumonia at the Adams County Memorial hospital.
