Mrs. John M. Myers, 74, lifelong resident of Blue Creek township, died at 12:05 o'clock this morning at her home one mile west of Salem. Death was caused by heart disease. She had been bedfast since October 10.

She was born in Blue Creek township June 17, 1872, the daughter of Elisha and Amy Closon-Merriman. She was married to John M. Myers December 22, 1895, and he died May 2, 1936.

Mrs. Myers was a member of the Union U.B. church.
