DEATH CLAIMS MRS. STALTER

Mrs. Emeline Stalter Dies Sunday at Home of Daughter

Mrs. Emeline Valentine-Stalter, 83, died at 11:30 a.m. Sunday at the home of a daughter, Mrs. Fred Zuercher, of Wabash township, with whom she had made her home for the past two years. Death was caused by infirmities. She had been bedfast for a week previous to her death.

She was born in Fairfield county, Ohio, September 11, 1857, the daughter of Christopher and Martha Fosnaugh-Spangler. Her first husband was Reuben H. Valentine. Her second husband was Noah Stauffer (sic). Both preceded her in death.

Surviving besides the daughter are another daughter, Mrs. Elma Essex of Monroe; a son, Allen H. Valentine of DeWitt, Ark., four brothers and one sister.

Funeral services will be held at 1:15 p.m. Tuesday at the Zuercher home and at 2 o'clock at the Winchester U. B. church, southwest of Monroe, Rev. R. F. Hart and Rev. L. Dellinger officiating. Burial will be in the Tricker cemetery near Salem.
