Glenn White dies after long illness

Glenn W. (William) White, 71, died at 10:50 a.m. Saturday at his home in Blue Creek Township, two miles west and one and one-half miles south of Willshire. He had been in failing health for the past two years.

Born in Mercer County, Ohio, November 1, 1898, he was a son of William E. and Martha Davis White, and was married to Glendola Case, March 19, 1925.

Mr. White was a retired farmer and former employee of the Central Soya Co.

Surviving are his wife; one son, William, Jr. White of Decatur, route 6; one daughter, Mrs. Merdith (Dorothy) Putman of Pompano Beach, Fla.; two sisters, Mrs. Emma Duke of Williamsburg, and Mrs. Martha Dott Morrison of Pleasant Mills; and eleven grandchildren.
