Oscar C. Young, 84, route 1, Monroe, died at 5:15 a.m. today in Adams County Memorial Hospital's extended care unit. He had been a patient there since June 5. He was born in Blue Creek Township on February 24, 1906 to William and Sarah Jane Richards Young and married Wilma Wendel on November 24, 1926; she survives. He was a self-employed truck driver who hauled stone and lime which he obtained through Meshberger Stone Co.; he retired about 19 years ago. He was also a farmer. Other survivors are a daughter, Mrs. Bill (Betty C.) Gaunt, 419 Rod St.; a son, Norman Young, route 2, Berne; eight grandchildren; and seven great-grandchildren. On son, Richard Young, died in November 1976. Three sisters, Cora Riff, Della Tinkham Ray and Martha Dague, and three brothers, John, Ray, and Lindsey Young, are also deceased. Funeral services are at 1:30 p.m. Friday in Zwick-Sefton and Jahn Funeral Home, Rev. Ersel Potts officiating. Burial will be in Tricker Cemetery. Visiting hours are 2-5 and 7-9 p.m. Thursday. Preferred memorials are to Salem United Methodist Church.
