

MRS. SAM S. EGLY DIES THIS MORNING

Mrs. Hila Egly, 77, of seven miles east and one-half mile south of Berne, died at 4:30 o'clock this morning at the Icel Shanks home in Hartford township, where she had been staying for some time. She had been ill of a cerebral hemorrhage for one year and bedfast for the past month.

Born in Mercer county, O., July 8 1886, she was a daughter of Newton and Emma Marbaugh-Smitley, but had spent most of her life in Adams county. Her husband, Sam S. Egly, preceded her in death in 1952.

Mrs. Egly was a member of the Bethel Brethren church, east of Berne.

Surviving are one son, Holman Egly of Berne route 2; two grandchildren; three great-grandchildren; five brothers, Archie Smitley of Decatur route 5, Clarence Smitley of Decatur, William and Chalmer Smitley, both of Berne route 2, and Ralph Smitley of Geneva, and three sisters, Mrs. Alva (Florence) Lawson and Mrs. Heber (Mildred) Feasel, both of Decatur, and Mrs. Ralph (Maris) Cristy of Berne route 2. One brother is deceased.
