Perry A. Everett, 79, route 8, died at 4 a.m. today at home, having been in failing health several years. He was the father of former Adams Count Assessor Anna Everett Spangler. He was born on October 5, 1905 in Pleasant Mills to Barney and Maude Railing-Everett. He married the former Bessie Irwin on November 23, 1925; she survives. A retired Root Township farmer and a retired Indiana Highway Department supervisor, Mr. Everett was active in local Republican party politics for many years, serving as precinct committeeman and vice-committeeman - a position he held at his death.
