Arlie Foreman, 69, of Route 2, Geneva, well-known retired farmer, died at 3:45 Thursday at the Adams County Memorial Hospital. He had been ailing for a year and death is attributed to a cerebral hemorrhage and was unexpected.

He was stricken Tuesday night and taken to the hospital Wednesday morning. He had been confined to a wheel chair for some time with a severe case of arthritis.

A son of James and Miranda Beabout Foreman, he was born on March 16, 1896 in Blue Creek Township and on June 30, 1917 he was married to Fern Teeter in Decatur.

Surviving besides his wife are two sons, Donald and Rolland, both of Route 2 Berne; one brother, Treman Foreman of Geneva; one sister, Mrs. Dee Tinkham of Berne, and four grandsons. Two brothers, Jesse and Manley and one sister, Mrs. Chauncey (Hulda) Sipe, preceded in death.
