

MRS. ROY MCDANIEL IS TAKEN BY DEATH

Funeral Services Tuesday Afternoon

Mrs. Myrtle McDaniel, 62, wife of Roy McDaniel, died at 4:45 o'clock Sunday morning at her home in Monroe. She had been ill for two years and bedfast for the past five months.

She was born in Washington township Sept. 11, 1889, and was married to Roy McDaniel Dec. 24, 1909.

She was a member of the Bethel United Brethren church, seven miles east of Berne, and the WSCS of the Monroe Methodist church.
