Roy Myers, 67, of Portland and a native of the Berne Community, died of a heart attack at 4 pm on Sunday. Myers was at Ed's Landing, Grand Lake, Celina, Ohio, when he was stricken and was dead on arrival at Gibbons Hospital in Celina.

Mr. Myers was born at Berne on March 11, 1900 and was a son of Mr. and Mrs. Henry Myers, now deceased. He was married to Bessie Steen, who preceded him in death in 1941.

Surviving are the following children: Louis, of Fort Recovery, O.; Roy Jr., of Portland; Raymond of Norfolk, Va.; Mrs. Marion (Marjorie) Ridger of Indianapolis; Mrs. Richard (Betty) Burkhart of Decatur; Mrs. Flory (Jean) Lastey, Dayton, O.; and Mrs. Vern (Vera) Kuhn of Rockford, Ohio. There are also 29 grandchildren and 12 great-grandchildren. A brother, Andrew Myers of Jefferson Township and a sister, Mrs. Nellie Hefner of Rockford, Ohio, also survive. While a resident of this community, he was a member of the Mt. Hope Methodist Church.

The body was taken to the Brockman Funeral Home in Fort Recovery, Ohio, where services will be held at 2 pm on Wednesday, with Rev. Charles Carlson officiating. Burial will be in Mt. Hope Cemetery in Blue Creek Township.
