Sipe, May 21, 1904, in Blue Creek township. The couple observed their golden wedding anniversary in 1954. Except for five years, during which time they resided in Muncie, Mr. and Mrs. Sipe lived east of Berne before moving to their present location.

R. and Manley Foreman, Decatur.
