

MRS POLLY HUFFMAN DIED AT AGE OF 95.

FUNERAL OF AGED GRANDMOTH-
ER OF EUGENE MORROW AT
LINN GROVE TUESDAY.

Mrs. Polly A. Huffman, who was aged 95 years and 8 months, passed away at noon Saturday at the home of her daughter, Mrs. H. E. Morrow, living just west of Linn Grove. Her death was due to the infirmities of her advanced age, and she had been slowly declining at the home of her daughter for some time. The aged woman was a native of Virginia, and came from that state to Indiana many years ago with her husband, who died in 1870. Surviving her are five children, the daughter, Mrs. Morrow, with whom she had lived for some time previous to her death, and four sons, three of whom are Ruley, Merryman L., and James live in Illinois and Albert Huffman who lives in Virginia. Eugene Morrow, clerk in J. L. Snyder's shoe store is a grandson.

The funeral services were held at the Morrow residence at 2:30 o'clock Tuesday afternoon, and burial was in the Linn Grove cemetery.

Ernst Morrow, the contractor, also is a grandson of the deceased Mrs. Huffman.
