

## DEATH CLAIMS FORMER RESIDENT

### Mother of Louie Neaderhouser Dies at Markle -- Rites Thursday

Mrs. Lena Neaderhouser, 88, mother of Louie Neaderhouser, passed away at 9:30 o'clock Tuesday evening, at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Al Stauffer in Markle, after having been ill since last Thursday with pneumonia. Mrs. Neaderhouser has been a resident of Markle for a goodly number of years, but had previously resided for many years in the Linn Grove area, where she was reared, married and reared her family.

She was a native of Warren, Pennsylvania, and came to this county with her parental family when a girl of seven years. Her father was Jacob Hoosier [see note]. She was born on March 11, 1852, bringing her age to 88 years and 11 months at the time of her death.

In 1878 she was married to Emanuel Neaderhouser, who preceded her many years ago. Surviving her are a son Louie of this place and two daughters, Mrs. Chris Martz of Fort Wayne and Mrs. Stauffer with whom she made her home.

She was the last surviving member of her parental family. Sisters who had lived in this community were Mrs. Caroline Runyon, Mrs. George Adler and Mrs. Mike Hoosier [see note]. A twin sister lived in Philadelphia, where she died.

Funeral services will be held Thursday afternoon at 2 o'clock from the Stauffer residence. Burial will be made in the Greenwood cemetery at Linn Grove.

NOTE: She was the daughter of Michael Huser. Jacob was her uncle and stepfather. Sisters were Caroline Runyon and Barbara Adler, BROTHER was Mike Hoosier. The sister who died was Sally/Sarah, she was referred to by both names.
