

Aged Monroe Woman Dies

Nancy Jane Parrish Succumbs to Illness Due to Complications

Nancy Jane Parrish, 81, of Monroe, died at her home at 8:30 o'clock Tuesday night following an illness due to a complication of diseases.

Nancy Jane Smith Parrish was born in Ohio, April 1, 1846. She has been a resident of Monroe for the last 16 years. Her husband, Joseph L. Parrish, to whom she was married 60 years ago, preceded her in death 30 years ago. A brother and two sisters also preceded Mrs. Parrish in death.
