Arthur Farlow Dies Tuesday at His Home

Rites Here Friday for Retired Farmer, 79

Arthur Farlow, 79, a well known retired Wabash Township farmer, died at his home at 11:25 am Tuesday after an illness of ten years. Death was attributed to arterio sclerosis. He resided two miles south and a mile east of the Tile mill corner just east of Berne. Mr. Farlow had been confined to bed for three years.

He was a native of Wabash Township and spent most of his life in this community. He was born February 14, 1887, a son of William and Effie Rawley Farlow. He was married to Fannie Cook Williams November 25, 1941.

Surviving are the widow; two sons, Wayne Farlow, Blythe, California and Dale Thomas Farlow, San Diego, California; a daughter, Mrs. Merrill (Clara) Weaver, Geneva; 15 grandchildren and 30 great-grandchildren; a brother, Sampson Farlow, Berne R.R. 2 and two sisters, Mrs. Gladys Ludy and Miss Jennie Farlow, both of Berne R.R. 2. A daughter, Mrs. Evans, a sister, Lizzie and two brothers, Eugene and Crawford Farlow preceded in death.

Mr. Farlow was a member of the First Missionary Church in Berne.
