

Lester L. Farlow Berne - 1913-2002

Lester L. Farlow, 89, of Berne, who had been the oldest World War II U.S. Army veteran in Adams County, died Monday, Aug. 26, 2002, at Swiss Village.

The Wabash County native was retired as a maintenance worker from Dunbar Furniture. He was a member of West Missionary Church.
