Mrs. Mary E. Gould Dies Friday Night
Funeral Services Monday Afternoon

Mrs. Mary Emily Gould, 91, a life-long resident of Adams county, died at 8:42 o'clock Friday night at the Adams county memorial hospital. She had been ill since December with carcinoma.

She was born in Adams county March 9, 1858, a daughter of Elisha and Mary Ann Ray. She was a member of the Monroe Friends church.
