

DIED OF HIS INJURIES

Abraham Lhamon, Adams County Native, Aged 80, Succumbs at Berne.

Berne, Ind., July 30.--Abraham Lhamon, aged 80 years, and a native of Adams county, is dead at the home of his son-in-law, Frank Meyers, with whom he stayed, of injuries received in a fall some time ago, when he broke his hip. His wife died last spring.

Mr. Lhamon had always lived in this county, was a veteran of the civil war and was held in high esteem.
