RACHEL McCUNE DIES THURSDAY

Former Adams County Resident Dies At Home Of Grandson

Mrs. Rachel McCune, 86, widow of the late Amos McCune, died Thursday night at 8:45 o'clock at the home of her grandson, Forest McCune in Lancaster township, Wells county.

Mrs. McCune, a former resident of the county, had been ill for eight days, suffering from influenza and complications.

She had resided near Berne the greater portion of her life. She was born in Ohio in December 1853, the daughter of George and Margaret Young. She was married to Amos McCune in 1871.

After the death of her husband a few years ago, she moved to the residence of her grandson. She was a member of the Maple Grove church near Berne.

Surviving is a daughter, Mrs. Mary Fleetwood of Jefferson township. Other than the grandchildren, no other near relatives survive.

Funeral services will be held Saturday afternoon at 1 o'clock at the home of the grandson and 1:30 (cut off)
