Lee E. PARRISH, 66, 208, E. Jackson St., Monroe, was fatally injured when he fell from a ladder at his home Tuesday at 8:30 p.m. He died at 9:20 p.m. in Adams County Memorial Hospital.

Mr. PARRISH, who retired in 1983 from Central Soya Co., after 38 years of service, was active in the Monroe Volunteer Fire Department, retiring after 30 years of service. He was a veteran on World War II.

Born in Adams County on 8 April 1920, he was the son of J. O. (OZ) and Daisy GILBERT-PARRISH. [his mother died when he was one year old and his father later remarried Bessie ANDREWS] He was married 14 October 1942, to Helen RAY, who survives.

Also surviving are two sons, Leo A PARRISH with the U.S Air Force in Rome, NY., and Merv L. PARRISH, Fort Wayne; one sister Helen MANN, Lynn; one brother Lake O PARRISH, Doylestown, PA., eight grandchildren and three great-grandchildren. Arrangements are pending at Winteregg-Linn and Haggard Funeral Home as the family is awaiting the arrival of the son, Leo from the Air Force.
