

JOHN SPANGLER WAS KICKED IN THE BREAST BY A VICIOUS HORSE ON LAST TUESDAY AND SERIOUSLY HURT. DR ANDREWS WAS CALLED TO HIS RESCUE. LAST FRIDAY EVENING, AT HIS HOME THREE MILES SOUTHEAST OF MONROE, IN, JOHN SPANGLER DIED FROM THE EFFECTS OF A KICK RECEIVED THE DAY BEFORE FROM HIS HORSE. THE DECEASED WAS BORN IN FAIRFIELD CO., OH, JULY 17, 1861, AND CAME TO ADAMS COUNTY NEAR 5 YEARS AGO AND WAS UNITED IN MARRIAGE TO MISS JENNIE GOULD, 9-5-1889. A WIFE AND CHILD ARE LEFT TO MOURN THEIR SAD LOSS. FUNERAL SERVICES WERE HELD AT THE VALLEY CHURCH, CONDUCTED BY REV. A J HUNT, OF RANDOLPH CO., IN. THE PLACE OF INTERMENT WAS AT THE BACKESTO CEMETERY.
