

PETER STEURY, WELL KNOWN FARMER DIES

Funeral Was Held At The Home of the Deceased This Forenoon at 9:30 O'Clock

Peter Steury, 66, well known farmer of four miles northwest of Berne, died at 5:30 o'clock Friday evening at the Adams County Memorial Hospital, following an operation for hernia. The immediate cause of his death was peritonitis.

Mr. Steury, who had enjoyed excellent health all his life, never being ill a day, took ill Tuesday, February 8, and was taken to the hospital where an operation was performed last Tuesday.

Mr. Steury had been a resident of Monroe township for more than 50 years, coming to this country when he was nine years old. His parents, Mr. and Mrs. John Steury, immigrated to this country in 1870 and settled in Monroe township.

The deceased was born in Canton Bern, Switzerland, September 25, 1861. When a young man he married Miss Mary Mazelin and to this union ten children were born, two of whom, John and Sarah Steury, are deceased.

Mr. Steury was a member of the Amish Christian church.
