MISS CARRIE ANDREWS DIES FRIDAY EVENING

Funeral Services on Monday Morning

Miss Carrie Andrews, 71, lifelong resident of Adams county, died at 5:30 o'clock Friday evening at her home one and one-half miles northwest of Monroe. She had been ailing from complications for several years, and critical for two days.

Born in Adams county June 16, 1877, she resided on the same farm her entire life. She was a member of the United Brethren church.

Surviving are two brothers, Ralph Andrews, at home, and Rex Andrews, of Kirkland township, and several nieces and nephews. One sister and 12 brothers preceded her in death.

Funeral services will be held at 10 o'clock Monday morning at the Black funeral home, the Rev. W. L. Hall officiating. Burial will be in the Ray cemetery, west of Monroe.
