GEO. ANDREWS DIED SATURDAY

Adams County Farmer Died Saturday Afternoon of Cancer

George Washington Andrews, 78, a lifelong resident of Adams county, died at his home one mile west and half mile north of Monroe, Saturday afternoon at 12:05 o'clock. Mr. Andrews was a well known farmer. Death was due to cancer. He had been ill since June.

He was born in Washington township, Adams county, October 7, 1855, a son of Julius Jonas and Ann Andrews. He was united in marriage to Lydia Jane Renicker-Andrews, and one child was born to the union. The son, Clifton, is deceased.

Surviving are the following brothers: Nathan Andrews, Allison Andrews, and James Henry Andrews, all of Washington township. A brother and sister and the parents are deceased.

Funeral services will be held Tuesday afternoon at 1:30 o'clock at the home near Monroe and at 2 o'clock at the Monroe Methodist Episcopal church. Rev. Elbert Morford will officiate and burial will be made in the Ray cemetery.

The body was returned to the Andrews home from the Lobenstein funeral parlors Sunday evening.
