

Monroe Lady Died Monday

Mrs. Matilda M. Andrews Died Following Two Paralytic Strokes

Mrs. Matilda Maria Andrews, age 75 years, widow of the late Perry Andrews, died at her home one mile west and one-half mile north of Monroe, at 9:45 o'clock Monday evening. Death was due to paralysis, she having suffered one stroke four weeks ago and a second one last Saturday.

Mrs. Andrews was a daughter of Martin and Elizabeth Schehrer, and was born in Columbiana county, Ohio, October 21, 1849. She spent most of her life in Adams county, Indiana, coming here when she was a child. She was the mother of fifteen children, ten of who preceded her in death. She also reared five of her grandchildren. Mrs. Andrews was a member of the Methodist church at Monroe. Her husband died February 10, 1923.

Mrs. Andrews is survived by five children: Ed Andrews, of east of Monroe; Rex Andrews, of Kirkland township, and Ralph, Arthur, and Miss Carrie Andrews, at home; fourteen grandchildren; seven great-grandchildren; two sisters, Misses Carrie and Elizabeth Scherer (sic), of Monroe; and one brother, Jacob Scherer, of Monroe.

Funeral services will be held from the residence at 1:30 o'clock Thursday afternoon, the Rev. S. I. Zechiel, pastor of the Monroe Methodist church, officiating. Burial will be made in the Ray cemetery, near Monroe.
