Nathan Andrews Died At Home of Brother Tuesday Night

Nathan Andrews, 77, a resident of Washington township for many years, died at the home of his brother, James H. Andrews, shortly after midnight last night. Death was due to complications.

Mr. Andrews was born in Washington township on June 30, 1857, a son of Thomas and Julia Ann Andrews. He was married in 1887 to Mary Kidwell who preceded him in death. Two sons and a daughter, born to the union, are deceased.

Mr. Andrews made his home with his brother, James Henry Andrews, for the past 35 years. Surviving are the two brothers, Alison Andrews and James Andrews of Washington township, and three grandchildren.

Funeral services will be held Friday afternoon at 1:30 o'clock at the home in Washington township and at 2 o'clock at the Monroe Methodist Episcopal church. Rev. Elbert Morford will officiate and burial will be in the Ray cemetery.

The body will be removed from the Lobenstein funeral parlors to the Andrews home this evening.
