Perry Andrews, son of Jonathan and Susan Andrews, was born on the farm in Washington township where his death occurred, November 25, 1845 being 77 years old at the time of his death. Mr. Andrews contracted a heavy cold about three weeks ago which developed into pneumonia, causing his death early this morning. Mr. Andrews lived his entire life on the same farm. he was a successful farmer and was highly esteemed by all who knew him.

Mr. Andrews served three years in the 11th Calvary during the Civil War. He had a fine record during his service and was honorably discharged. About fifty-six years ago he was married to Mathilda Scherer, also of Washington township.

The wife, six children, one half-sister, fourteen grandchildren, and four great grandchildren survive. The children are Ed, John, Arthur, Carrie, Rex and Ralph, all of Washington township. The half-sister is Mrs. Anna Essex, of Monroe.

Funeral services will be held from the home at 1:30 o'clock Monday afternoon, the Rev. Rackenbaugh, officiating. Burial will be made in the Ray cemetery.
