Dick Andrews is Dead

Son of Hazel Andrews Died at Stuttgart, Arkansas - Remains to Arrive Tonight

Dick Andrews, eldest son of Hazel C. Andrews, who removed from here to Arkansas about two years ago, is dead, the result of a several years' illness with dropsy. The sad news was received here this morning in a telegram which read as follows:

Stuttgart, Ark., Aug. 21. Lew Wise, Decatur.

Dick is dead. We are on the way. Tell City and Zwick to meet the Clover Leaf train Thursday evening. Funeral Friday at two p.m. Tell all the folks. H. C. Andrews

The deceased is about twenty-eight years old and popular among his large circle of friends here. He has suffered from poor health for several years, but the change to Arkansas seemed to benefit him greatly for some time. Recently it was learned that his health was failing again, still this message caused a severe shock. The telegram gives all the information that is known at this time. It is supposed that the death occurred early yesterday morning and the message was probably delayed on account of poor service during the telegraphers' strike.
