Max O. Bahner, 85, of Berne, the first draftee in 1941 from Adams County, died Monday, May 20, 2002, at Adams County Memorial Hospital in Decatur.

The Monroe native retired in 1972 from U. S. Government Veterans Administration and was a member of Monroe United Methodist Church.
