DEATH CLAIMS DECATUR LADY

Mrs. Franklin Click Dies This Morning At Home in This City

Mrs. Frank Click, 78, died at 8:30 o'clock this morning at her home on 315 South Eleventh Street of complications. She had been ill for some time.

Mrs. Click was born in Kokomo, but had spent most of her life in or near Decatur. She was first married in 1878 to Mathias Brandyberry, who died May 29, 1923. She was remarried Oct. 3, 1925 to Frank Click, who survives.

Surviving children are Mrs. Sadie Foreman of Ft. Wayne, Mrs. J. N. Burkhead of Monroe, Dennis Brandyberry, Mrs. Forest Fleck and Mrs. Neil McDonald all of Ft. Wayne, Mrs. Walter Duke of Albany, Mrs. Roger Conner of Winchester; nine step-children; 22 grandchildren; 15 great-grandchildren and one great-great-grandchild. One daughter, three brothers and four sisters are deceased.

Funeral services will be held Monday at 2 o'clock at the home and at 2:30 o'clock at the U. B. Church, of which she was a member. Burial will be made in the Ray cemetery, next to her first husband, Mathias Brandyberry. The Rev. James A. Weber, pastor of the church, will officiate.

The body will be returned Sunday morning at 9 o'clock from Zwick funeral home and may be viewed there until the time of the funeral.
