M. O. Brandyberry Is Taken By Death Funeral Services To Be Wednesday

Millard Otis Brandyberry, 61, a lifelong resident of Adams Co, died at 6 o'clock Sunday morning at his home in Monroe. Death was attributed to complications resulting from a fall 11 months ago at the Central Soya company, where he was employed on the research farm.

He was born in Adams county April 20, 1890, a son of Amos R. and Cinda Brandyberry, and was married to Flossie Laisure Sept. 27, 1911.

Surviving are his wife; his mother; and three sisters, Mrs. Ethel Branch and Mrs. Addie Lobenstein of Monroe and Mrs. Frank Hartnett of Scottville, Mich. One brother is deceased.

Funeral services will be conducted at 1:30 p.m. Wednesday at the home and at 2 o'clock at the Monroe Methodist church, the Rev. W. L. Hall and the Rev. Vernon Riley officiating. Burial will be in the Ray cemetery, west of Monroe. The body will be removed from the Lobenstein funeral home to the residence, where friends may call after 7 o'clock this evening.
