Native of Wells County Dies At Adams County Hospital

Mrs. Amanda Burkhead, 75, wife of M. F. Burkhead, of Decatur, passed away at the Adams County Hospital at 6:30 o'clock this morning after a three weeks illness. Death was attributed to influenza, resulting in pneumonia. She was taken to the hospital Monday where her condition grew rapidly worse.

She was born in Wells county, January 26, 1853, the daughter of Trader and Elizabeth Ball. Her parents died when she was quite young and she moved to Adams county with relatives.

She was married fifty-five years ago today to M. F. Burkhead.
