

## MONROE WOMAN EXPIRES TODAY

### Mrs. Melinda Corson Dies At Her Home West of Monroe

Mrs. Melinda Good Corson, 71, died at her home, 2 miles west of Monroe at 11:30 o'clock this morning of hemorrhage.

She was born in Adams County, June 16, 1860, the daughter of Jacob and Anna Beery-Good, both deceased. On April 10, 1914 she was united in marriage to John B.
