Abraham Hahn Dies Here This Morning - Funeral Services Friday Afternoon

Abraham Hahn, 81, retired laborer, died at 9:25 o'clock this morning at his home on Line street. Death was caused by complications. He had been in failing health for the past six years and bedfast for two weeks.

He was born in Jay county Sept. 9, 1862, the son of Jacob and Mary Hahn, and had lived in Decatur since 1916. He was a member of the Methodist church.

Surviving are the widow, Mary Ellen, a son, Homer Hahn, and two grandchildren. One daughter preceded him in death.

Funeral services will be held at 2 o'clock Friday afternoon at the home, with Rev. Byron Leaser of the Monroe Friends church officiating. Burial will be in the Ray cemetery near Monroe. The body will be removed from the Lobenstein funeral home to the residence at 2 o'clock Thursday afternoon.
