Christian A. Inniger, 75, Rt. 1, Monroe, a prominent Adams County farmer and well-known DeKalb seed corn dealer, died at 9:45 p.m. Sunday at the Adams County Memorial Hospital, following an extended illness.

He was a member of the Monroe United Methodist Church and the Monroe Lions Club.

Born in Monroe Township on Sept. 8, 1906, he was the son of Abraham and Sarah Schwartz-Inniger, and was married on Oct. 5, 1940 to Helen Roop, who survives.

Also surviving are two sons, John R. Inniger, Rt. 1, Monroe; Donald L. Inniger, Rt. 1, Monroe; three sisters, Mrs. Silvan (Susan) Sprunger, Berne; Mrs. Rose Viers, North Manchester; Mrs. Boyd (Frieda) Stepler, Linton; and four grandchildren, Shelly, Erika, Scott and Mike Inniger. One brother preceded him in death.

Funeral services will be held Wednesday at 10 a.m. at the Monroe United Methodist Church, with Rev. William K. Rapp officiating. Burial will be in the Ray Cemetery.
