Death Claims Monroe Woman

Mrs. Eliza M. Johnson, 77, Dies This Morning; Funeral on Monday

Monroe, May 18.-- (Special)-- Mrs. Eliza M. Johnson, 77, wife of Levi Johnson, died at 11 o'clock this morning, Saturday, May 18, 1929, at her home in Monroe. Death was caused by a complication of diseases with which Mrs. Johnson has suffered since the holidays.

Eliza M. Johnson was a daughter of Jesse and Eliza Smith and was born in Adams county, April 25, 1852. For the past eighteen years, she has resided in Monroe. She is a member of the Zion Christian Union church southwest of Decatur.

Surviving are the husband and the following children: Mrs. James Kessler, Mrs. Ab Everhart, Jesse Johnson, of Monroe; Perry Johnson of Decatur; James Johnson and Mrs. Alta Emma Teems, of Toledo, Ohio. Three children preceded the mother in death.

Funeral services will be held Monday afternoon at 1 o'clock, standard time, at the residence, and at 1:30 o'clock, standard time, at the M. E. church in Monroe. The Rev. Vernon Riley will officiate, assisted by the Rev. D. V. Williams. Burial will be made in the Ray cemetery.
