

## Death Claims Levi Johnson

### Prominent Retired Farmer Dies This Morning at Monroe

Levi Johnson, 85, well known Adams county retired farmer, died in Monroe at 1:20 o'clock this morning. Death was caused by complications after an extended illness. Death occurred at the home of his daughter, Mrs. Sarah Everhart in Monroe in whose home he had been staying. The deceased was born in Tuscarawas county, Ohio, August 29, 1851. He came to the community of Monroe when a young man.

He wife, Eliza M. Johnson, preceded him in death May 19, 1928. Three children are also deceased.
