

## NOAH JOHNSON DIES TODAY AT HOSPITAL

Double Funeral Services Friday

Noah Johnson, 7, farmer living two and a half miles west of Monroe, died at the Adams County Memorial Hospital this morning at 9 o'clock of complications, developing from influenza and pneumonia. He has been in poor health for some time, blind for the last year, and seriously ill since last Friday.

His brother, Levi Johnson, 75, died Monday evening at 6:20 o'clock of a cerebral hemorrhage. The two lived together on Noah Johnson's farm and after Noah was taken to the hospital it was necessary to remove his brother to the county home as there was no one to take care of him.

Double funeral services will be held for the two brothers at the Monroe Methodist Church, Friday at 1 o'clock, with Rev. E. O. Kegerreis, pastor of the church officiating. Burial will be in the Ray Cemetery at Monroe. Previously, services had been announced for Thursday, but will be delayed a day.

Neither of the brothers had ever married. They are survived by one sister, Mrs. Matilda McGown, of Miamisburg, Ohio, and a number of nephews and nieces, including Frank Uhrick and Frank L. Johnson of Decatur, and Mrs. N. Hahnert, of Monroe. three brothers and three sisters are deceased.
