**Monroe Resident Is Taken By Death  
Arminda B. Laisure Dies This Morning**

Mrs. Arminda Belle Laisure, 76, lifelong resident of Monroe, died at 2:30 o'clock this morning at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Waneta Malchle, four miles west of Decatur. She had been in failing health for several years and bedfast for six days.
