VIRGIL LAISURE DEATH'S VICTIM

Monroe Resident Dies This Morning of Complications

Virgil C. Laisure, 66 year old brickmanson (sic) and farmer, died at his home in Monroe at 11:10 o'clock this morning. Death was due to complications.

Mr. Laisure was born in Adams County January 20, 1868, a son of Homer and Levina Laisure. He was united in marriage to Arminda Wagoner.

The deceased spent his entire life in Adams County. He was a former member of Winchester United Brethren Church.
