MONROE CITIZEN DIED SATURDAY

Herman Osterman, Age 54, Succumbed To Stroke of Paralysis

Herman Osterman, age 64, well known resident of Monroe, died at his home in that town at 5 o'clock Saturday evening, following a short illness of paralysis. Mr. Osterman was stricken with paralysis about a week ago.

Funeral services were held from the home at 1:30 o'clock and from the methodist church at 2 o'clock this afternoon, the Rev. S. I. Zechiel officiating. Burial was made in the Ray cemetery.

Mr. Osterman was born in Indiana, December 25, 1859. He had lived in Monroe for the last forty years. He was a son of Mr. and Mrs. Jonah Osterman. Mr. Osterman's wife died ten years ago. He is survived by two sons, E. O. Osterman, of Monroe, and Homer Osterman, of Fort Wayne, one sister, Mrs. Anna Schrader, of Fort Wayne, and one brother, John Osterman, also of Fort Wayne. There are eight grandchildren and a host of other relatives and friends.
