LEWIS SAPP DIES AFTER LONG ILLNESS

Lewis F. Sapp, 6, of 716 High Street, well known retired farmer, died at 12 noon Saturday at the Adams County Memorial Hospital. He had been in failing health for six years and critically ill for one week.

Born in Adams County August 4, 1897, he was a son of Owen U. and Selina D. Showwalter Sapp, and was a lifelong resident of the county. He was married to Laura Brown January 4, 1947.

Mr. Sapp was a member of the Loyal Order of the Moose.
