TEEN DIES IN 2-CAR CRASH IN WAUSEON

DECATUR, Ind. - Two persons, one an Adams County youth spending the summer at Wauseon, O., were killed in a two-car traffic accident at 5:40 a.m. Tuesday in Wauseon.

Dead are Donald Ray Slaven, 15, of Decatur, and Diane Clark, 11, of Wauseon.

Injured in the accident was another girl, Jeanne Plassman, 15, of Wauseon, a passenger in Slaven's car, and the driver of the other vehicle, Bernadine Snyder, 35, of Waterville.

Toledo Post, Ohio Highway Patrol, stated Slaven was northbound on Road 13 and apparently ran a stop sign at the intersection of County Road D. The injured were taken to the Fulton County Health Center.

Slaven was the son of Miriam Slaven of Rt. 4, Decatur. Several brothers and sisters survive. The body has been returned to Zwick Funeral Home.

The death marks the third traffic fatality this week of Adams county residents. Robert W. Fuller, 46, of Berne, was killed Sunday and Frederick W. Aumann, 53, of Rt. 1, Decatur, died Monday.
