

**Brought To Old Home For Burial**

Decatur, Ind., June 16 --- Perry Andrews, a farmer living six miles south of this city near Monroe, has received the sad announcement of the death of his sister, Mrs. John Strait, of Sunbury, O., formerly of this county. The death occurred Sunday night, resulting from a long illness with a disease of a cancerous nature. The deceased was about sixty-one years of age. She was born in this township, the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Jonathan Andrews, long deceased. Five years ago she removed with her husband to Sunbury, O. where she has since resided. Besides her husband she is survived by two children -- Mrs. Lizzie Nelson and Hosea Strait, of Sunbury. She has but one brother, Perry Andrews, and a half sister, Mrs. Jesse Essex, of near Monroe. The body will be brought here for burial, arriving Wednesday afternoon at 2 o'clock over the Erie. The funeral procession will proceed at once to the M. E. church at Monroe, where the funeral sermon will be preached at 3 o'clock by the Rev. Jones. Burial in the Ray cemetery.
