

## GENEVA RESIDENT ANSWERS SUMMONS

### HENRY UHRICK DIES AT HIS HOME AND FUNERAL WILL BE HELD SATURDAY

Henry Elmer Uhrick, 73, died at his home in Geneva Wednesday after an illness of over half a year suffering from carcinoma.

The decedent was born in Adams county, March 14, 1867, a son of William and Sarah Ann Laisure-Uhrick. He was married to Rebekah Ann Brandeberry who survives. The couple had been married 49 years last August.

Survivors other than the widow include two sons, Vern O. Uhrick of Geneva, and Edward R. of Fort Wayne; two brothers, Clark of Jackson, Michigan, Otto of Dunkirk; a sister, Mrs. Vida Elzey, of Fort Wayne; two half-brothers, Wilburt and Nelson, both of Akron, O., a half-sister, Mrs. Edith Richard of Michigan; 14 grandchildren and three great-grandchildren. A daughter is deceased.

Funeral services will be held at the residence in Geneva Saturday morning at 9:30 and at 10 o'clock at the Friends church in Monroe. Burial will be in the Ray cemetery.
