SAMUEL UHRICK DIES TUESDAY

Native Of Adams County Dies Tuesday Of Infirmities

Samuel L. Uhrick, 89, pioneer resident of Adams County, died late Tuesday afternoon at the old people's home in Allen County. Death was attributed to infirmities.

The deceased was born in Monroe Township December 1, 1848, the son of Henry and Nancy Uhrick. His wife Sarah E. Johnson Uhrick, preceded him in death. He had resided in this county until 11 years ago, when he moved to Fort Wayne.

Surviving are three sons: Ira F., of this city; John H., Daniel L., both of Fort Wayne; and a daughter, Mrs. Ida Cook of San Diego, Ca. One brother is deceased.

Funeral services will be held Friday afternoon at 1:30 o'clock at the S. E. Black Funeral Home in this city and burial will be made in the Ray Cemetery a Monroe. The Rev. James A. Weber, pastor of the First U. B. Church, will officiate.
