W. W. Wilkinson dies at hospital

William W. (Red) Wilkinson, 76, of 504 Elm street, a resident of this area most of his life, and a retired truck driver, died at 9:35 a.m. today at the Adams county memorial hospital, where he had been a patient one day.

Born in Decatur July 15, 1894, he was a son of John H. and Minerva Woods-Wilkinson.
